How a Combat Biathlon Team Relay Works	<p>Each team has 2 members. They can be mixed gender or the same gender. All male competitors will be handicapped with a slightly longer run than females.</p> <p>Team members will be numbered 1 and 2. No team will know the numbering of other teams before the start of the event.</p> <p>Fencing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This will be one hit epee, in one minute (dependent on entry numbers) - All teams will fence each other. Team members numbered 1 will fence each other and those numbered 2 will fence each other. - Final team score will be total hits scored. <p>Shoot/Run:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The combined event will start after the fencing. - The points scored in fencing are converted into seconds. The team with the most points starts the combined event first, followed by other teams dependent on fencing score. - Example: If the second team are 20 points behind the first team in the fence, they will start 20 seconds behind the first team, and so on. - The combined event will be 4 laser shoots and 4 runs with the females running 400m each time and the males running slightly farther each time. * - Each team member will do 2 shoots and 2 runs, then tag their team mate who will then go. The team to cross the line first will be the winning team!

	- All laser equipment will be provided with instruction and coaching given before the combined event phase.
Who can enter	This event is open to ALL, (16+ age on 31/12/16) both beginners and experienced. All competitors must be a member of Scottish Fencing OR Scottish Pentathlon / PGB
Awards	Best Team Fence, Best Team CE, 1st to 6th Teams Overall.
Rules	Rules can be downloaded at www.pentathlongb.org . The rules will be adapted to suit this event. The run distance is shorter.
